Heart to Heart Chat – 11.24.2024

My dear Friends,
The first parish I served in our diocese was St. Joseph's, Moorhead. The first day I arrived in Fargo on July 7th, 2005, Msgr. Mike Foltz came with 10 wonderful people from the parish to welcome me including the Deacon and Sr. Doreen Charest. I felt so welcomed into this country. My first three years of ministry were an amazing experience of learning as well as accompanying people with true love. I never wanted to quit that parish. I am ever grateful

to Msgr. Mike for offering such a positive and great experience of pastoral ministry in serving the people of God with true joy. As we are celebrating Thanksgiving Day this week, I would love to draw your attention to this wonderful feeling we need in our lives very much. Research in positive psychology indicates the role of gratitude in our overall wellbeing. "Gratitude helps us note and appreciate positive experiences, build strong relationships, deal with adversity, improve our health, increase our resiliency, and view the future more confidently and optimistically. When that gratitude is directed to God, our intentions move beyond our own wellbeing toward the wellbeing of others David Boudrot '96." This is an essential tool in us that can orient our lives towards God's Kingdom with true hope, longing and great joy. If this is the psychological dimension of gratitude, the spiritual side of it makes greater sense. As we hear in the story of the ten lepers healed by Jesus, only one leper comes back to thank Jesus. And he was a Samaritan. For him getting reunited with his family took the second place but coming back to Jesus took the first place in his heart. His heart was overflowing with gratitude and love for Jesus that he could not but come back and thanked him. From his example we see that gratitude is what brings us back to Christ. As we pray in our Liturgy, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God," and the response is, "It is right and Just." We want to thank and praise God constantly for all the goodness we enjoy in our life. They all come from Him alone. Without His gracious gifts, we don't have much to enjoy in our life. So, it is right to thank Him. It is just because, when we benefit from His goodness, we are called to be just to our brothers and sisters too. I am so grateful to God having created me as a human person and calling me to do His work of love. I am so thankful to each one of you in these parishes that you invited me into your hearts and families to be your spiritual leader. I thank the Lord for each one of you that He gives me the grace to work for you as a good shepherd. Let us think this week, what I am thankful for? If I am grateful to God for certain things in my life, what way do I want to express this to God and to those who are a blessing to me in my life? Let us grow ever joyful by thanking God because it's gratitude that makes us joyful.
