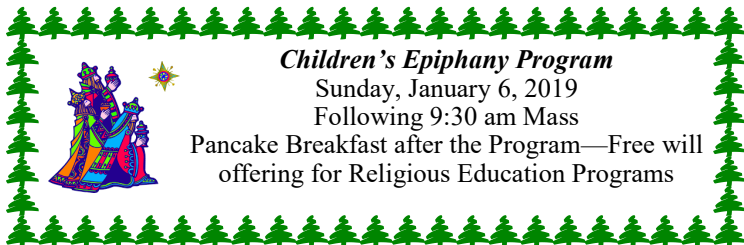

† January 6, 2019 - Epiphany of Our Lord

"...the Gentiles are co-heirs, members of the same body, and co-partners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the Gospel." (Ephesians 3:6)

Today we celebrate that Christ came to all of us, not just the Hebrews. He has given each of us unique gifts. We all have different yet equally valuable roles to play in the Body of Christ. Pray daily and ask God how He wants you to use your gifts so that we may all "be one".

† That a star announced Jesus' coming shows that God holds all of the universe in care and love. As we celebrate that God sent Jesus to people of all nations, we will want to remember that creation is to be respected and honored. Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato Si'* calls for humankind to examine how the planet is treated. Each of us will want to consider how we treat the signs and wonders God has given us.

- ◆ If you could choose a sign to announce your birth, what would it be?
- ◆ What gift (s) would you want to bring Jesus, Mary, and Joseph if Christ were born today?
- ◆ On this celebration of the Epiphany, gift each other with a service, experience, or something else that is not a material good. The gifts of the Magi were symbolic. What could each person in the family do for others that would carry significance?
