My dear friends,

Is this the worst situation humanity ever faced? I don't think so. There had been worse human made disasters than the pandemic we face and all the consequent closures, including our Sunday masses. How do we respond to this situation as faithful disciples of Jesus? When the disciples were with Jesus in a boat and the boat was tossed by a severe storm and wind, fearing that they are going to sink, the disciples woke Jesus up asking to save them. Jesus rebukes the storm, and everything calms down. The only words Jesus used were "Be not afraid." While we are amid any crisis whether social or personal, we must remind ourselves with the words of Jesus, "Be not afraid. I am with you." He is the master of our life. Even when the worst of problems that shake the boats of our life, he is sitting with you in the boat. He is not trying to stand outside and calm your fears. He is in the middle of it and reassuring you that he will not abandon you. This fundamental trust in our Lord should be the basic attitude of each one of us at this moment of crisis. Pray and use the name of Jesus more often. Be informed of your situation from the media and take proper care of your personal hygiene. Other than that, don't panic about anything else. Do the essential things you need to do and leave the rest to the Lord. Be charitable to others by being prayerful and helpful to other vulnerable people around you. Use this time to read some comforting and spiritually assuring good books. They are available online too. We all can use this time to grow spiritually. Take some quiet time with the Lord to take a list of all the good things you have done to grow in your spiritual life. Take a list of all the good things you intended to do but failed regularly. Start right now to take some baby steps to initiate few spiritual ways that are beneficial to your soul. Let us pray more Rosaries and seek the great intercession of our Blessed Mother to save us from this grave situation. Pray in a special way for those countries that are severely affected by the virus. Kindly watch and pray the Holy Mass on local TVs on Sundays. Let us hope that this situation will soon come to an end that we can come and thank God together as faithful of God.
