My dear friends,



When I was teaching in a major seminary in India, I liked Cricket (a game so popular in India) a lot. This is a different version of the baseball. I was so excited about the one-day Cricket matches, I used to be awake till midnight to know the result. I did not need any extra encouragement to stay awake because I loved the game so much. It is all about how we are involved in some-things in our life.

What about our involvement in our faith life? Does it take all your energy to drag yourself to the Church on a Sunday or do you get ready with all enthusiasm? The difference springs from what kind of energy and focus you want to invest on your faith. My faith is not one of the 10 things I need to take care of in my weekly life. It is the first and foremost thing I need to pay attention among all other duties of a week. My week should start with my personal conversation and interaction with the Eucharistic Lord. He must set the tone of my whole week. His words should inspire me as to decide on the different issues I face as a worker in my workplace and a Father or a Mother in my family. My faith should constantly come to the forefront to inspire me, encourage me and lead me to do the right things for me and my family. This faith I am talking about is nothing but an active and lively relationship with my Lord who wants to be part of my life always. In this relationship, our Lord is very steadfast and consistent in His Love. He expects us to reciprocate His love in the same way. 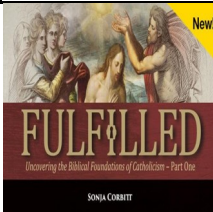
